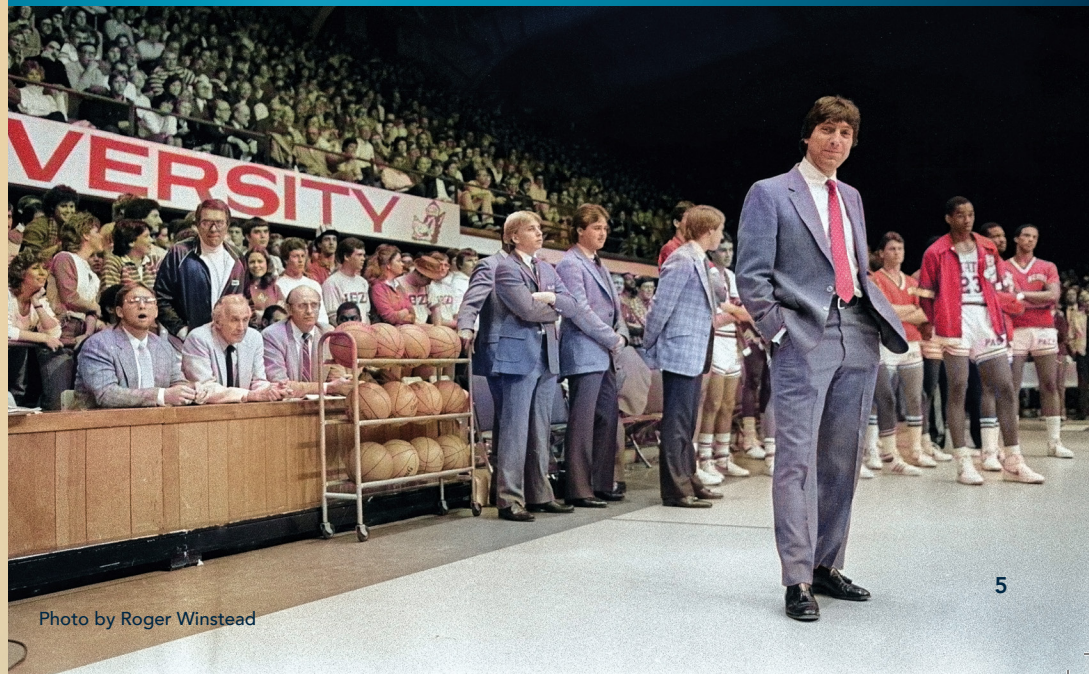

- Your paddle is registered in your name. Please guard it with your life.
- Date, time and location restrictions may apply. Some local taxes, facility fees and tips may be charged at time of redemptions, including any hotel taxes and resort fees. These are not covered by the V Foundation unless otherwise stated.
- All dates shall be mutually agreeable to both the donor and buyer.
- Full payment, in United States dollars, must be made within 72 hours following the conclusion of the Auction on the evening of September 20, 2024 in Chicago, IL, unless other arrangements have been agreed upon by the V Foundation.
- We accept payments of stock & wire transfers, payments by cryptocurrency, payments by check and charitable funds transfers. Payments made by credit card can be made with MasterCard, Visa, Discover or American Express. Bidder may guarantee by credit card until an alternate form of payment is received by October 18, 2024
- We are happy to accept Donor Advised Funds (DAFs) as payment for cash donations, including Fund-A-Need. IRS regulations prohibit the use of Donor Advised Funds (DAFs) towards donations that can be perceived as a benefit. We cannot accept DAF payment for admissions or auction purchases.
- The auctioneer is the agent for the seller. No bid shall be valid unless acknowledged by the auctioneer.
- All accounts must be paid in full, or guaranteed with a credit card, prior to lot release.
- These Conditions of Purchase, as amended by addenda or oral announcement during the sale, constitute the entire terms and conditions of seller with respect to the sale and purchase of auction lots listed herein. By bidding, the bidder agrees to be bound by these Conditions of Purchase.
- The auction item may not be awarded to the winning bidder if it is an experience-based/non-tangible item, if at any time up to the date of receipt of the item the donor fails to conduct themselves without due regard to public morals and decency, or if the donor commits any act or becomes involved in any situation or occurrence tending to degrade the donor in the community, or which brings the donor into public contempt or scandal, or which materially and adversely affects the reputation or business of the V Foundation, whether or not information in regard thereto becomes public, The V Foundation at its sole discretion may refuse the winning bid and not award it to the donor.
- Chicago Sales Tax of 10.25% will be added to the purchase price of all applicable auction lots.
- All sales are final.
- For federal income tax purposes, the V Foundation is classified as a tax-exempt corporation under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)3. Bidders may be entitled to deduct a portion of their payments for auction lots as a charitable contribution. Each bidder should consult his or her tax advisor regarding deductibility for state and federal income tax purposes.
- Items are available for pick-up on the evening of the auction, September 20, 2024.
- All shipping arrangements, expenses and insurance are the responsibility of the buyer. Declared value is based on replacement value, not gavel value.

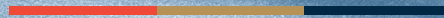
